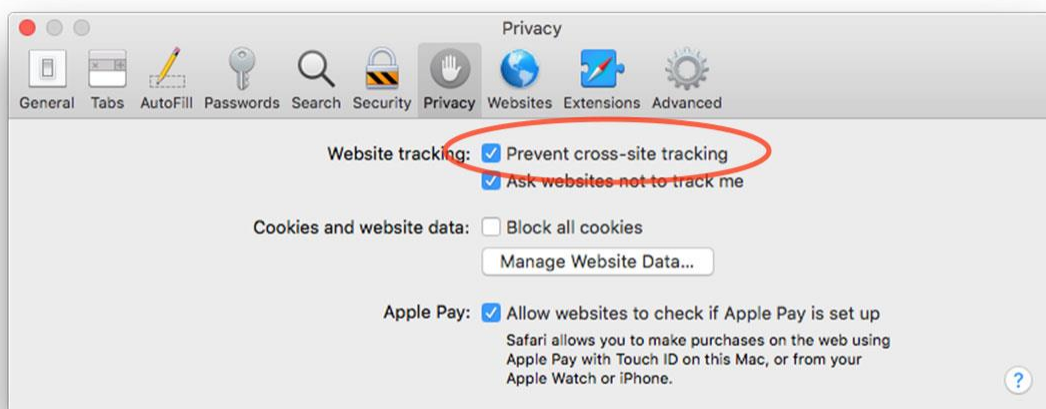


Disable Prevent Cross-Site Tracking on macOS

You can see if Prevent cross-site tracking is enabled in Safari on your Mac, and even turn it off. Here's how:

- Launch Safari on your Mac
- Go to **Safari > Preferences** from the menu bar
- Click the **Privacy** tab
- Uncheck **Prevent cross-site tracking**



Disable Prevent Cross-Site Tracking on iOS 11

Disabling the Prevent cross-site tracking setting on your iPhone and iPad is similar to the Mac, but not exactly the same. Here's what to do:

- Tap **Settings**
- Tap **Safari**
- Disable **Prevent Cross-Site Tracking**
